IF YOU ARE IN A TRAFFIC ACCIDENT

DO NOT DO THE FOLLOWING

- **DO NOT** Panic or Leave the Scene.
- **2.** DO NOT Move Your Vehicle Unless a Police Officer Tells You To Do So.
- **S. DO NOT** Guess at Any Information Given to a Police Officer.
- DO NOT Admit to ANYONE that the Accident is Your Fault or Say "I'm Sorry."
- **5. DO NOT** Promise To Pay Any Bills or To Fix the Other Driver(s) Car(s).
- **6. DO NOT** Plead Guilty to Any Traffic Ticket Until You Consult with a Lawyer.
- **7.** DO NOT Say to Anyone that You Are Not Hurt, Unless You Are Absolutely Sure.
- **3. DO NOT** Discuss the Accident with Any Insurance Adjuster or Sign Any Insurance Documents Until You Consult with a Lawyer.

IF YOU ARE IN A TRAFFIC ACCIDENT

DO THE FOLLOWING

- Do See if Anyone is Hurt, Call 911 for Emergency Help, and Render First Aid.
- 2. DO Warn Oncoming Traffic with Flares or Warnings. If You Are Unable, Get Someone Else To Do This. ALWAYS Carry Flares and First Aid Equipment in your Car.
- 3. DO Call Police (911), Even if the Damage Seems Slight.
- DO Seek Prompt Medical Attention for Any Injury, No Matter How Slight.
- **5.** DO Obtain the Name(s) of the Other Driver(s) in the Accident and Their Insurance Company(s).
- 6. DO Get the Name(s), Address(s), and Telephone Number(s) of Any Witnesses at the Scene.
- **7.** DO Report the Accident Right Away to Your Insurance Company Regardless of Fault and File All Necessary Accident Reports.
